The Boy Scouts will follow the banner with the American Flag. The Girl Scouts will follow behind them.
Everyone else will join behind.

Remember to be as GREEN as you can be. Green hats, beads, shamrocks, green hair etc.
We will have tattoos, green beads, and hats available for first ones there.
Please wear comfortable shoes!!!!
