

1st Grade Spanish students at St. Patrick’s will be reintroduced to thematic lesson plans and new vocabulary and concepts in Spanish spanning a lesson over two days allowing the covered material to process mentally before it is reviewed. Both classes will center on a common theme. The first class will introduce the vocabulary and concepts with the second class reviewing the material including a physical activity. Students will develop into individuals with the ability to recite the Spanish alphabet, days of the week, basic colors, numbers 1-50, sing Spanish songs and speak common Spanish words. Teacher will provide student opportunities to understand language through the use of various strategies and various techniques. The students will gain experience by listening, singing, repeating, role play, and writing, memorizing, and finally speaking. Students’ progress will be assessed using Foreign Language Standards ***Standards: Communications, Cultures, Connections, Comparisons, and Communities** *Standards are used as a checklist for Foreign Language class written works, any homework and classroom projects. A major part of assessment is student’s classroom participation in activities and discussion.
