The students will know and understand the parts of the Mass which is the best public prayer. They will learn about the various vocations and be aware that their everyday actions are holy. Students will know the Ten Commandments and will grow in their moral consciousness. They will perform acts of social justice and service to their community which demonstrate their love for Jesus and response to God’s call to serve.
